### BSG Expected Budget 2018-19

Academic Year FTE  $(7,250 \times $200) = $1,450,000$ 

Summer Term FTE  $(2,000 \times $15) = $30,000$ 

**Projected Total Budget = \$1,480,000** 

# Administrative/ Payroll Projections

- BSG employs approximately 60 students/ year
- Minimum wage increases
  - Department Directors and Employees will see a \$1.00 raise
    - \$11.75/ hour for Directors
    - \$11.25/ hour for coordinators and office assistants
- 7 office assistants will be hired to balance this account
  - Previously, 15 have been hired
- Priority Services (WBSU The Point and The Stylus) will see hourly wage increases

### Collaboration Initiative

- Form on myBrockport
- Open to all Departments, Organizations, Clubs
- Collaboration Committee
- Budgeting \$30,000
  - 2017-18 budget, \$15,000
  - Spent over \$20,000 in co-sponsorships

# **Priority Services**

- WBSU The Point
  - Employment during breaks and the Summer sessions
  - Supporting technology for live streaming and podcast recording
  - Travel account of \$1,170
- Talon Television
  - Purchase of new equipment to support additional membership
  - Payroll Accounts 2019-2020
- The Stylus
  - Printing costs have been reduced by \$6,000 (\$1,450 per issue x 22 = \$31,900)

# Club Operation Expenses

- Club Sports
  - Paid a lump sum of \$50,000 twice a year
- BSG Funded Clubs (\$180,000)
  - Academic Council 15%
  - Cultural Council 31%
  - Service Council 27%
  - Social Arts Council 27%
