EXAMINE STORYTELLING

- In the Intercultural Storytelling course, you will receive an introduction to the principles of storytelling
- After selecting a media such as Video, Podcast, Graphic Novels, Games, Theater, Non-fiction narratives (and more!) ...you will explore the storytelling process through that medium

- In the SDG course, you will also explore a tough problem, framed by the SDG to which you are assigned.

- In the group project phase of the program, you will work on telling the story of your assigned organization, based on their needs.
- You will interact with staff at the organization, applying the lessons learned from the Storytelling course and in relation to your assigned SDG to give them materials they can use in their work right now.
- You'll learn about another country and culture, the challenges people there experience and how that community is taking action.

- The program culminates in a live showcase of your work and a celebration of all your efforts!
- You will present your storytelling projects and hear feedback from your peers and the community-based organizations with whom you have been collaborating over the course of the program



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
