The Ronald E. McNair Post-Baccalaureate Achievement Program, a US Department of Education grant, is named for the African American astronaut who died in the Challenger tragedy. Its purpose is to prepare undergraduate low-income, first-generation college students and students from groups underrepresented in graduate education for doctoral studies leading to university teaching.

General support for the program includes:

A stipend during the academic year
Free content tutoring
Communication, presentation and computer skill development
Graduate GRE preparation
Workshops, seminars, and other motivational activities

Faculty/research mentors will:

Advise you in academic career areas
Direct you to career resources
Oversee your graduate application process
Supervise you in research and help you with your Scholars Day presentation

Students entering their senior year will:

Receive a stipend
Conduct intensive research with a mentor
Meet regularly for seminars during a seven-week period
Present preliminary findings at a summer research conference
